Public Notice 2022 General Election County of Carroll, State of Arkansas

Pursuant to Arkansas Election Law, Arkansas Code Annotated 7-5-202, all qualified electors are notified that the 2022 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. The election will submit to a vote of the electorate all candidates by name and office and all other measures and questions required by law to be submitted to the electors. The following polling places have been set by the Carroll County Board of Election Commissioners and are hereby posted in accordance with the election laws of the State of Arkansas. The polls will be open from 7:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

EARLY VOTING will begin on Tuesday, October 24, 2022 and will be conducted at the Carroll County Airport at 518 CR 308, Berryville, AR 72616 and at St. Elizabeth Parish Center at 232 Passion Play Rd., Eureka Springs, AR 72632. The last day to Early Vote is Monday, November 7, 2022. Early voting is not conducted on Sundays. Hours will be: Weekdays – 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Saturdays – 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, November 7th – 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Absentee voting will be conducted through the Carroll County Clerk's Office, 210 W Church Ave., Berryville, AR 72616. The telephone number is 870-423-2022.

The deadline for the County Clerk to receive absentee ballot applications by mail, fax, or e-mail for the General Election is November 1, 2022.

Absentee ballots will be processed and canvassed daily November 1st – November 7th, 2022.

Absentee ballots will be opened, processed and canvassed beginning at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at the Carroll County Clerk's Office.

Early voting and absentee votes will be counted at 7:30 p.m. on November 8, 2022 at the Carroll County Courthouse, 210 W Church Ave., Berryville, AR 72616.

THE DEADLINE TO APPLY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN THE GENERAL ELECTION IS October 10th, 2022.

PUBLIC LOGIC & ACCURACY TESTING of the voting equipment for Early Voting and Election Day will begin at 1:00 p.m. Friday, October 14, 2022.

November 6, 2022 is the deadline to apply to register to vote in the General Runoff Election on December 6, 2022.

The Carroll County Board of Election Commissioners will meet on November 14, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. at the Carroll County Clerk's office for the Provisional Ballot Hearing.

The Carroll County Board of Election Commissioners will meet on November 18, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. at the Carroll County Clerk's Office to certify the results of the 2022 General Election.
