

WHEREAS: the Carroll County Search and Rescue building, located at the Carroll County airport, is in dire need of repair.

WHEREAS: the current state of the building requires renovation to prevent future loss and expense to the county.

WHEREAS: the failure to repair this building is a safety hazard due to structural problems with the main support beams.

WHEREAS: due to lack of proper insulation, utility bills are very expensive.

WHEREAS, Wambold Construction has agreed to repair all the problems, at a cost of \$33,000.00 with half of the amount due at contract signing and the other half at job completion.

NOW THEREFORE: be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Carroll County, State of Arkansas, that:

Section 1: The sum of \$33,000.00 is appropriated to County Buildings (1000-0111), line item: Improvements (4003).

Section 2: Under Arkansas Code §14-22-102 bidding procedures are not required and the proposal by Wambold Construction without soliciting a bid is hereby approved.
