BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CARROLL, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

**A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING
ORDINANCE 2022-39 (THE 2023 BUDGET ORDINANCE) AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO COUNTY BUILDINGS (1000-0111).**

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court recognizes that from time to time the Budget Committee may not appropriate enough funds to operate certain departments.

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court also recognizes that due to the unexpected expenses of necessary structural repairs and replacement of equipment to some County Buildings, in particular the Health Department and the S.O.R.T building, that adequate funds to cover such repairs had not been appropriated at the beginning of the year.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Carroll County, State of Arkansas, to appropriate \$6,5000 from County General (1000) to County Buildings (0111) \$5,000 to line item (4004) Machinery and Equipment and \$1,500 to line item (3009) Other Professional Services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CARROLL, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

**A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AMENDING
ORDINANCE 2022-39 (THE 2023 BUDGET ORDINANCE) AND
APPROPRIATING INSURANCE FUNDS FROM COUNTY GENERAL (1000) TO
THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE (1000-0400) BUDGET**

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court realizes that any paid insurance claim funds coming to the County must be receipted through the Treasurer's office and is deposited to the appropriate fund.

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court also realizes that these types of receipted funds are occasionally appropriated back to a department's budget through an appropriation ordinance when requested by the department head or elected official.

ORDINANCE 2023- 37

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CARROLL COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE ACKNOWLEDGING AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY'S CONTINUED CONTRACTED SERVICES OF CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS UNDER ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §14-14-1202

WHEREAS, from time-to-time certain offices within county government finds it necessary to contract services with certain individuals and employees whose services are outside of their normal work responsibilities and those relationships and circumstances are to be acknowledged and authorized under Arkansas Code Annotated §14-14-1202.

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2022, county employee, Wendi Lawhorn, contracted as an independent contractor engaged in cleaning services to the Prosecuting Attorney's office and has extended the contract thru December 31, 2023.

WHEREAS, employee Scottie Collins, is the spouse to Efilessette Collins who provides cleaning services for the county road department and the Western District Courthouse building. She has provided this type of service to the Health Department in the past (see Ord 2019-66).

WHEREAS, Anna Morris is a part-time employee for the Berryville Public Library who provides contracted cleaning services on the weekend and works as a librarian. She has a current contract dated June 30, 2023, with no date of expiration.

WHEREAS, that from 2022 until July 11, 2023, Denette Cooper, had provided contracted cleaning services to the Western District Courthouse in addition to her regular duties as deputy clerk to the Circuit Clerk. She no longer provides this service to the county.

WHEREAS, all of the individuals listed above have provided the necessary equipment, labor, and expertise that is sufficient to meet the contract & agreement requirements of Carroll County, Arkansas; and,

WHEREAS, the security of confidential legal documents, the locations, and availability of the services required creates unusual circumstances under the provisions of ACA §14-14-1202 that authorizes the County to continue to use these services.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Carroll County, State of Arkansas:

Section 1: That the Quorum Court of Carroll County, Arkansas, hereby declares that it is in the best interest of the County to continue to use the services provided by Wendi Lawhorn, Efilessette Collins, and Anna Morris.


Section 2: That the Quorum Court of Carroll County, Arkansas, further declares that it was in the best interest of the County for Denette Cooper to have provided services until July 11, 2023.

Section 3: That the Quorum Court of Carroll County, Arkansas declares that due to the security of confidential legal documents and the county's general rural nature being a hindrance to the availability of properly vetted companies and/or individuals to provide these services, this creates the unusual circumstances that authorizes and acknowledges the county use of the same under Section 1.

Section 4: That the contracts of the individuals listed in Section 1, should they continue past their current expiration date, be further acknowledged and authorized between the parties and the County Judge until such time the contract either expires or is terminated by mutual agreement.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is necessary to ensure the continued operation of the County and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.
