EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-19

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CARROLL COUNTY ARKANSAS;
AND ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS COUNTY ROAD
MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT TO MADISON COUNTY, ARKANSAS; AND FOR
SUCH OTHER PURPOSES AS TO EFFECTUATE A TRANSFER OF SAID PROPERTY.**

WHEREAS, Carroll County currently has certain road maintenance equipment that is surplus, no longer of benefit to the County, and currently incurs costs for regular and routine maintenance and upkeep;

WHEREAS, Madison County Arkansas has made inquiry as to the availability of said road maintenance equipment;

WHEREAS, Madison County officials and Carroll County officials have come to an agreed value of the road maintenance equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Carroll County to transfer the said property;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT FOR CARROLL
COUNTY ARKANSAS:**

ARTICLE 1. This Order is passed pursuant to the power granted to the Quorum Court by the State of Arkansas under A.C.A. Section 14-16-116.

ARTICLE 2. The Quorum Court of Carroll County, Arkansas authorizes the County Judge to exchange and transfer all that certain road maintenance equipment scheduled on the two bills of sale attached collectively hereto as exhibit "a" and incorporated herein by reference as if it had been set out at length verbatim, to Madison County, Arkansas in exchange for the consideration set out therein.

ARTICLE 3. This transfer and exchange is exempt from the normal procedures of Sections 14-16-105, 14-16-106, 14-22-101, and 19-11-201.

ARTICLE 4. This transfer and exchange is made on the terms and conditions as contained in the bills of sale.

ARTICLE 5. The County Judge shall execute such title transfer documents as necessary to consummate this transfer and exchange, receive the consideration property and deposit same to the Carroll County Treasurer.

ARTICLE 6. A copy of this Ordinance duly certified by the County Clerk shall be filed in the office of the Carroll County Clerk along with the bills of sale.

ARTICLE 7. This Ordinance is confirmed by a 2/3 majority vote of the Quorum Court.

ARTICLE 8. The recitals in the preamble of the Ordinance are hereby incorporated into this article of the Ordinance by reference.
