**ORDINANCE 2024-03**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CARROLL COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:**

**AN ORDINANCE TO CLARIFY POSITION NAMES WITH THE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND ESTABLISH WAGE RANGES**

**WHEREAS**, under ACA §14-14-1206(a), the Quorum Court of each county shall fix by ordinance the number and compensation of all county employees.

**WHEREAS**, for several years the Sheriff's office has had twenty-one (21) officer positions which include the Sheriff and the Chief Deputy until the passage of Ordinance 2023-21, dated May 16, 2023, to add a deputy position in conjunction with an agreement with Holiday Island to provide law enforcement to the municipality, making the officer positions allowed by the Quorum Court at twenty-two (22).

**WHEREAS**, the Quorum Court finds it necessary to clarify through ordinance the officer positions and to establish the maximum 2024 hourly wage for each officer position and to rename the positions to the needs of the current Sheriff of Carroll County.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF CARROLL COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1:** It is hereby confirmed that the Sheriff's Office currently has twenty-two (22) officer positions that include the Sheriff, and the Chief Deputy funded on 50/50 allocated basis between the Sheriff's budget (1000-0400) and that of the Detention Center budget (3018-0418). (see Ordinances 2023-21 & 27). In addition, there are support staff members who are not deputies.

**Section 2:** The following is a listing of all positions in the Sheriff's office, their 2024 approved maximum wage as requested by the Carroll County Sheriff and approved by Budget and Personnel Committees of the Quorum Court on January 18, 2024:

- Section 3:** Said positions are APERS retirement eligible, if applicable and/or required by APERS and are to be considered full-time (80 hours per pay period/86 allowed for law enforcement) positions with all applicable benefits, unless otherwise indicated.
- Section 4:** Said positions titles will begin with the first full payroll after approval and publication of this ordinance with the final determination date indicated by the Affidavit of Publication from the newspaper as received by the County Clerk.
- Section 5:** A new wage letter will be required of the Sheriff's office listing the employee with their assigned position and hourly rate to be paid in accordance with this ordinance. The hourly rate may be lower than the approved maximum wage approved but may not go over the allowed annual rate per position and rounding down the hourly rate to the nearest hundredth will to be taken into consideration by the County Clerk when rounding is necessary so as not to go over the allowable annual maximum pay per position.
- Section 6:** The position names listed may not be changed by the current Sheriff or by future Sheriffs except through the appropriate committee processes and passed by Ordinance.
- Section 7:** As the amount of budgetary needs did not change, the 2024 Budget Ordinance hereby does not require amendment.
- Section 8:** If any provision of this Ordinance is found to be invalid by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, phrases, and provisions of this Ordinance which remain valid and enforceable.
