Quorum Court
January 5, 2022
Special Meeting

The Quorum Court met on Wednesday, January 5, 2022 at the Eastern District Courthouse, Berryville for a special meeting to fill the vacancy left by Frankie Kay Phillips-Brown. The meeting was recorded, press notified with no one from the press being present. Prosecuting Attorney Tony Rogers and Deputy Prosecutor Steven Simmons were also present. In attendance also were Vicky Hopper (Collector candidate), David Writer, Ronda Griffin, and County Clerk Connie Doss. The Roll Call had all Justices present except JP Jack Deaton.

Judge Barr asked JP John Howerton to lead the group in the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was called to order at 5:00pm. County Clerk Connie Doss read the Resolution Declaring the Appointment of a Successor to fill the Vacancy of the Office of Tax Collector. Other than JP Chuck Olson commenting that this was a necessary process, there were no other comments or questions for Ms. Hopper. The Judge call for the vote and with only JP Jack Deaton being absent, the Quorum Court all voted to have Ms. Vicky Hopper fill the position of Carroll County Tax Collector.

Judge Barr thanked everyone for attending and the meeting was adjourned at 5:07pm with a motion by JP Roger Hall and seconded by JP Larry Swofford.
